## PROVISIONAL PROMOTION OF ACADEMIC STAFF 2021/2022

### 1. From Associate Professor to Professor



**Prof. Method Kazaura (Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics)**

His last promotion to Associate Professor was in 2017. Prof. Kazaura has earned **9.05 points** (6.05 from Eleven (11) publications in peer reviewed journals, 1<sup>st</sup> author in Three (3), and 3 from teaching).



**Prof. Daud Simba (Department of Community Health)**

His last promotion to Associate Professor was in 2012. Prof. Simba has earned **10.18 points** (7.18 from Fifteen (15) publications in peer reviewed journals, 1<sup>st</sup> author in Six (6) and Five (5) consultancy reports, and 3 from teaching).

## 2. From Senior Lecturer to Associate Professor



**Dr. Tumaini Nyamhanga (Department of Development Studies)**

His last promotion to Senior Lecturer was in 2016. Dr. Nyamhanga has earned **10.85 points** (7.85 from Nineteen (19) publications in peer reviewed journals, 1<sup>st</sup> author in Three (3), Four (4) Consultancy reports and One (1) chapter in a book, and 3 from teaching).



**Dr. Paschal Ruggajo (Department of Internal Medicine)**

His last promotion to Senior Lecturer was in 2019. Dr. Ruggajo has earned **10.49 points** (7.49 from Twenty-One (21) publications in peer reviewed journals, 1<sup>st</sup> author in Three (3), One (1) technical report and Seven (7) conference abstracts, and 3 from teaching).

**Dr. Larry Akoko (Department of Surgery)**

His last promotion to Senior Lecturer was in 2019. Dr. Akoko has earned **9.37 points** (6.37 from Sixteen (16) publications in peer reviewed journals, 1<sup>st</sup> author in Five (5), Three (3) review articles, Two (2) case reports and Seven (7) conference abstracts, and 3 from teaching).
