TEACHING METHODOLOGY COURSE FOR EDUCATIONAL AND HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS

INTRODUCTION

The School of Nursing MUHAS is planning to conduct a short course on Teaching Methodology for Educational and Health Care Professionals from **25th March to 03rd May 2024** (six weeks).

Location: Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS) located in **Dar es Salaam region**.

Aim: The aim of the course is to prepare health personnel to become providers of quality health care and education services at any health care and educational institution in the country.

Target groups: The course attracts all cadres participants from both public and private health care facilities and training institutions in Tanzania and other countries. The course is also open to other professionals dealing with training education.

Course Duration: The course will run for **SIX weeks from 25th March to 03rd May 2024, 03:00PM – 06:00PM; Monday to Friday**.

Course Fees: Each participant will be required to pay a total of **Tshs. 640,000/=** for local citizens and a total of **USD 300** for foreigners which should be paid through **control number** that will be provided after receiving the invitation letter.

The applicant should pay the fee in advance and submit pay in slip at least 2 weeks before starting of the course.

Note: Travelling costs, meals and accommodation is not part of the course fees. Applicants will have to arrange the said services.
