### A CALL FOR TRAINING WORKSHOP ON SCIENTIFIC WRITING AND COMMUNICATION-DOCEHTA (26<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY–1<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2024)

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#### Introduction

The need for capacity building in scientific writing and communication that a researcher needs to know and master in order to successfully position his or her research and career is a prerequisite for effective research. A Short-term Course in scientific writing and Communication, organized by the Strengthening Doctoral Education for Health in Tanzania (DOCEHTA) Project, is advertised.

This Course focuses on the basic principles of scientific writing style and composition, applying these principles to writing research papers, review articles, grant proposals, research statements, as well as to preparing academic presentations and posters. This Course equips the participant to promote research publications in high impact Scopus Indexed Journals. The course aims at unraveling the nuances of scientific writing and communication with eminent Subject Matter Experts.

5. Adherence to ethical use of sources and academic integrity

- Critical thinking in scientific reading and writing
- Literature search: Identification of research topics and knowledge gap
- Language matters in academic writing
- Writing for publication
- Citation and referencing skills
- Presentation skills

### **Who should attend?**

Preferably, Masters and PhD students as well as early-career researchers and more senior colleagues with limited research experience.

### **Facilitators**

This workshop will be facilitated by highly qualified and experienced expertise in research from MUHAS, UDOM and the Academic Writing Centre at University of Oslo in Norway.

### **Course fee**
