A CALL FOR TRAINING WORKSHOP ON SCIENTIFIC WRITING AND COMMUNICATION-DOCEHTA (30th SEP TO 4th OCT. 2024)

Introduction

This Short-Term Course aims at equipping Postgraduate students and early-career with academic writing skills to promote the writing of dissertations and research publications in high-impact journals. In specific terms, the course intends to unravel the nuances of scientific writing and communication by engaging in an intensive practice under the facilitation of research and writing experts from the University of Dodoma (UDOM), the University of Oslo (UiO), and the Muhimbili University of Health and Applied Sciences (MUHAS). After the Course, participants are expected to develop a deeper understanding of the principles of scientific writing and composition and be able to apply the principles in writing research papers, review articles, grant proposals, research statements, and preparing effective and engaging academic presentations.

The Course aims at capacity building in:

- Developing scientific, technical writing, and communication skills
- Hands-on usage of related tools and techniques of scientific writing
- Effective dissertation and manuscript writing, publishing papers in top-notch and high- impact journals
- Exhibiting aptitude to communicate scientific findings using language in the written and spoken form appropriately, and
- Adhering to the ethical use of sources and academic integrity.

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Course content

- Critical thinking in scientific reading and writing
- Literature search: Identification of research topics and knowledge gap
- Language matters in academic writing
- Writing for publication
- Citation and referencing skills
- Presentation skills

Who should attend?

Preferably, Masters and PhD students as well as early-career researchers and more senior colleagues with limited research experience.

Facilitators

This workshop will be facilitated by highly qualified and experienced expertise in research from MUHAS, UDOM and the Academic Writing Centre at University of Oslo in Norway.

Course fee

Course fee is **400,000.00 TZS (Tanzanians) or 200 USD (for non-Tanzanians) for non MUHAS students and 200,000.00 TZS** for MUHAS students. The course fee covers; Tuition fee, course materials and certificate.
