Why Join the AfroRehab2030 project?

Expertise needed

We are looking for someone with experience in one or more areas such as: Erasmus+ or other capacity building projects in higher education, evaluation and quality checks of Erasmus+ and other educational projects.

Role and responsibilities

You will be part of the Quality Group and work closely with the External Experts. The group will further develop the Quality Plan for the project and perform quality exercises throughout the project period to enhance the deliveries of the project. Based on the checks you will produce reports and make joint quality recommendations to the project coordinator.
