1. Objective

2. Requirements

- a. Cover Letter (*max 1 page, font size 11*)
 - i. Provide a brief narrative of your background/qualifications, interest in implementation science, and your career goals
- b. Statement of motivation (*max 2 pages, font size 11*)
- c. Curriculum Vitae (max 2 pages, font size 11)
- d. One Letter of Recommendation from your immediate supervisor (for those employed) or from your undergraduate supervisor
- e. Proof of application to Master of Public Health in Implementation Science at MUHAS.
- f. Copy of your transcripts and certificates

3. Award

The scholarship will cover the following

- a. Full cost of tuition fee
- b. Dissertation research expenses as per MUHAS guidelines

- Research experience
- Personal commitment
