



SHORT COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT

RESEARCH ETHICS

This course provides an introduction into the history and development of research ethics, its core principles and the application of these principles in research in Tanzania. Research ethics will provide early career researchers with knowledge and skills of research ethics and good research practice and improve the ability to critically reflect upon ethical issues/questions that can arise during research.

Eligibility: Preferably, junior and senior staff, as well as students with a passion for research. Additionally, academicians, researchers, medical doctors, and other relevant professionals with at least a bachelor's degree or its equivalent are encouraged to participate

Mode of Delivery: In Person (Interactive, Hands-On Sessions)

Fees: A course fee of 300,000 TZS or 170 USD will be charged for non-Tanzanians and non-MUHAS-affiliated applicants. The fee should be paid through control numbers which will be provided after the notification of acceptance.

Facilitators: This course will be delivered by highly qualified and experienced expertise in bioethics from within and outside the Country
