SHORT COURSE IN BASIC ASSISTED REPRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY (ART)

Introduction:

The Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS) in collaboration with Muhimbili National Hospital (MNH) – Upanga and Hull and East Riding Fertility Clinic-UK (HERF-UK), is pleased to announce the first *short course in Basic Assisted Reproduction Technology (ART)* to be held from 11th - 15th August, 2025.

Aims and Content:

This course is intended to equip gynaecologists with knowledge and skills necessary to offer basic ART care.

The following major topics will be covered:

- Basic concepts of reproductive biology and infertility
- Evaluation of an infertile couple
- Different advanced ART options and their applications
- How to perform Intra-Uterine Insemination (IUI) (including semen preparation)
- Application of Quality Assurance measures to improve patient outcome
- Legal and ethical dilemmas in ART


Eligibility / Who should attend?

This course is intended for MCT certified Obstetricians and Gynaecologists who provide care and treatment to couples struggling with delayed conception.

Venue:

Videoconference Room, Ground Floor, CHPE Building (for theory sessions) and MUHAS skills laboratory and microbiology research laboratory (for practical sessions). Participants will also visit the Mama Samia Suluhu Hassan IVF center at MNH.

Course fee:

Each Tanzanian participant will be required to pay a total of TZS 350,000/-, which will cover tuition fee, meals, venue and other requirements for the course. Participants will be responsible for their travel and accommodation expenses. The fee for non-Tanzanians is USD \$140. Once you have been selected for the course, a control number will be issued and you will be contacted to finalize payment.
