Introduction

Eligibility criteria for Al Muntazir Islamic International Special Needs Education Scholarship applicants: -

- 1. Enrollment into Bachelor of Science Audiology, Speech & Language Pathology (BSc. ASLP) and Bachelor of Science in Occupational Therapy (BSc. OT) Programs
- 2. Possession of admission letters into Bachelor of Science Audiology, Speech & Language Pathology (BSc. ASLP) and Bachelor of Science in Occupational Therapy (BSc. OT) Programs.
- 3. A female candidate is highly encouraged.





Other required qualities:

- 1. The applicant must be creative, hard-working, with good communication skills, and with a genuine interest in the special needs education sector
- 2. Should be self-motivated and committed to meeting the expected objectives
- 3. Should be able to work independently
- 4. Should be able to organize and act as an effective "Team Leader"
