FERST is an acronym for "**France Excellence – Research Stay Tanzania**". This scholarship from French Government is aimed at researchers from Tanzanian institutions at Doctoral level and above. Beneficiaries will receive funding for up to six months for research stay at a French Institution during the first semester 2026, No extension beyond the duration initially planned is possible.

Application Process:

- Complete and submit the scholarship form and supporting documents
- Selection by an independent committee based on: Research topic relevance, Academic quality
 of the project, Need for mobility and Interest of host institution / alignment with priority themes
- Selection timeline: 4 to 6 weeks
