### 1.0 MUHIMBILI UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH AND ALLIED SCIENCES (MUHAS)

The Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS) is a Tanzanian Premium Health and Allied Sciences University established in 2007 through Article 1 of the Charter of Incorporation in line with the Universities Act No 7 of 2005. Since its establishment, MUHAS has managed to have a range of programmes in biomedical, clinical and allied health sciences which necessitates increasing of number of staff to perform its intended function. In this context, MUHAS is inviting applications from suitable candidates for various posts as itemized below for teaching the programmes across seven Schools and one academic Institute of the University.

### 1.1 JOB SUMMARY

The MUHAS Specialized Dental clinic is located at the School of Dentistry building and provides specialized dental services and training to dental students. Dental laboratory and radiology are adjunct units and they are well established and functional. Our goal is to improve health and wellbeing of our communities through quality dental services provision and training of dental students.

### 1.1.2 TYPE OF EMPLOYMENT

This is a full-time contractual employment for a period of two (2) years.

### 2.1 DENTAL SURGEON II - 1 POST

#### 2.1.1 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- (i) To provide routine dental health services to in-patients and out-patients;

- (ii) To attend and assist oral and maxillofacial surgical procedures;
- (iii) To supervise, train and guide dental students and other staff;
- (iv) To carry out investigations, follow-up and recommend measures for preventing dental
- (v) disease outbreaks;
- (vi) To carry out research and publish results for consumption by other experts
- (vii) To design and formulate strategies for improvement of quality in dental services delivery; and
- (viii) To perform any other related duties as may be assigned by supervisors.

### **2.1.2 QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE**

Holder of Bachelor Degree in Dental Surgery (DDS) from a recognized Institution who have successfully completed one-year Internship and has been registered by the Medical Council of Tanganyika as a Dental Officer.

## **3.1 RADIOGRAPHIC TECHNICIAN II- 2 POSTS**

### **3.1.1 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- (i) To ensure that the radiation protection in the department is maintained;
- (ii) To perform and interpret intra oral dental x-rays, CBCT, head and neck CT scan, and Ultrasound;
- (iii) To maintain and keep x-ray equipment and supervise sterilized radiology instruments in the unit;
- (iv) To ensure quality diagnosis of x-rays is taken;
- (v) To maintain and keep patients x-ray waiting for seniors to interpret and give results;
- (vi) To attend on job training, train junior staff and provide technical advice on radiation in the unit;
- (vii) To process and prepare x ray images using available software;
- (viii) To maintain and keep patient's records; and
- (ix) To perform any other related duties as may be assigned by a supervisor.
