### **TITLE: CLINICAL ETHICS**

#### **Introduction**

Quality medical services need not only good clinical acumen but also decisions based on ethical standards. In clinical services ethical issues may easily be overlooked. The general aim of the course is to orient health care provider to recognize the importance of being sensitive to ethical issues within everyday clinical practice and develop in them the ability to effectively address the ethical concerns of patients

#### **Learning outcomes**

At the end of this course the participant is expected to;

1. Apply basic principles of biomedical ethics in their daily patient care
2. Discuss patients' involvement in their own care plan using informed consent
3. Analyze ethical dilemmas in patients' care
4. Describe how to Solve ethical dilemmas in patient care
5. Describe practitioner's ethical obligation to attend patient during emergency

#### **Course content**

1. Introduction to clinical ethics and ethical theories relevant clinical care Delivery
2. Principles of biomedical ethics in clinical care
3. Decision-making models in-patient care
4. Ethical handling of patient information
5. Beginning of life ethics
6. Obligation of the provider in epidemics/pandemics

#### **Who should attend?**

Preferably, Junior and Senior staff and Students who have passion Research, Others are Academicians, Researchers, Medical Doctors and Other relevant Professionals with at least a bachelor/equivalent levels education.

### **Mode of instruction**

A combination of approaches will be used through this online training including: lectures, assignments, seminars, discussions, demonstrations role play, videos and case discussions.
