Introduction

MUHAS and action medeor, Germany, sharing common objectives, have agreed to enter a cooperative arrangement as outlined in a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). This collaboration focuses on scientific research, development, and training in various fields of pharmacy, including, pharmaceutical quality assurance, industrial pharmacy, medical product regulation and clinical pharmacy.

For the academic year 2026/2027, action medeor will offer one scholarship to support training at the Pharm R&D laboratory or any program within the School of Pharmacy. The scholarship will cover the amounts specified in the MUHAS Postgraduate Guidelines. Therefore, MUHAS invites eligible candidates to apply for this scholarship opportunity.

Eligibility Criteria for Action Medeor Foundation Scholarship Applicants:

1. Must possess an admission letter to a Master's program in one of the relevant disciplines listed above.
2. Should be working in underserved or previously unserved areas, the local pharmaceutical industry, MUHAS, or another health university, health facility, or research institution.
3. Priority will be given to outstanding applicants with a GPA of 4.0 or above.
4. Female candidates are highly encouraged to apply.

Other Required Qualities:

1. The applicant must be creative, hardworking, have good communication skills, and demonstrate a genuine interest in pursuing a research career.
2. Should be self-motivated and committed to meeting the expected objectives.
3. Must be capable of working independently.
4. Should possess strong organizational skills and the ability to act as an effective team leader.
